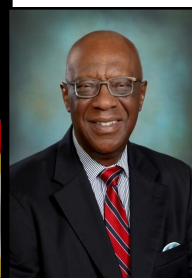

What do you like to do for fun? "In my free time, I listen to music and play video games."

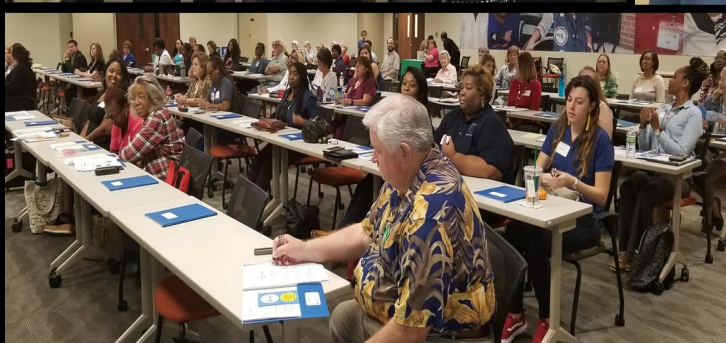
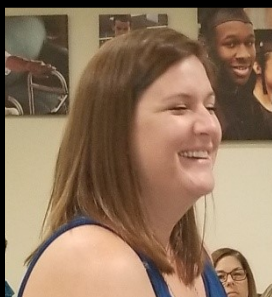

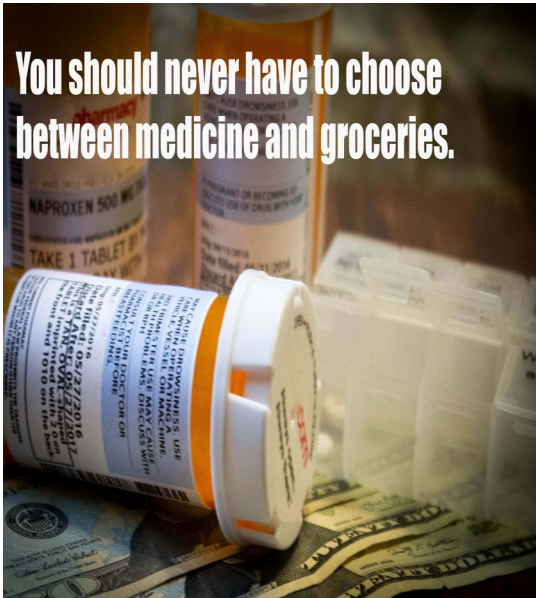
